



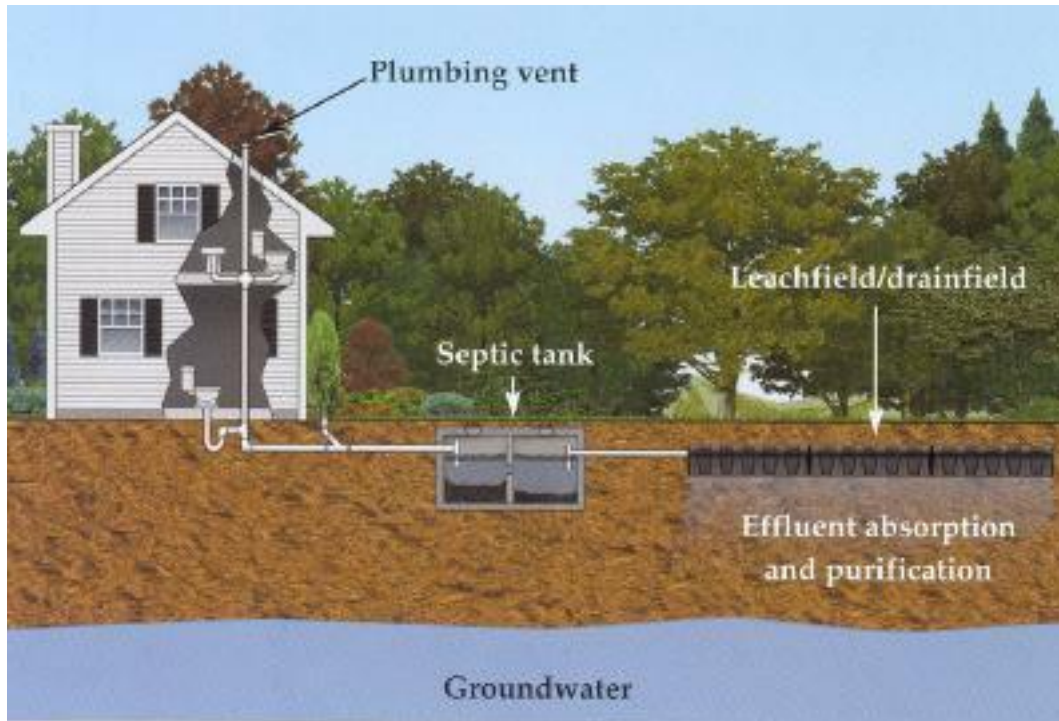

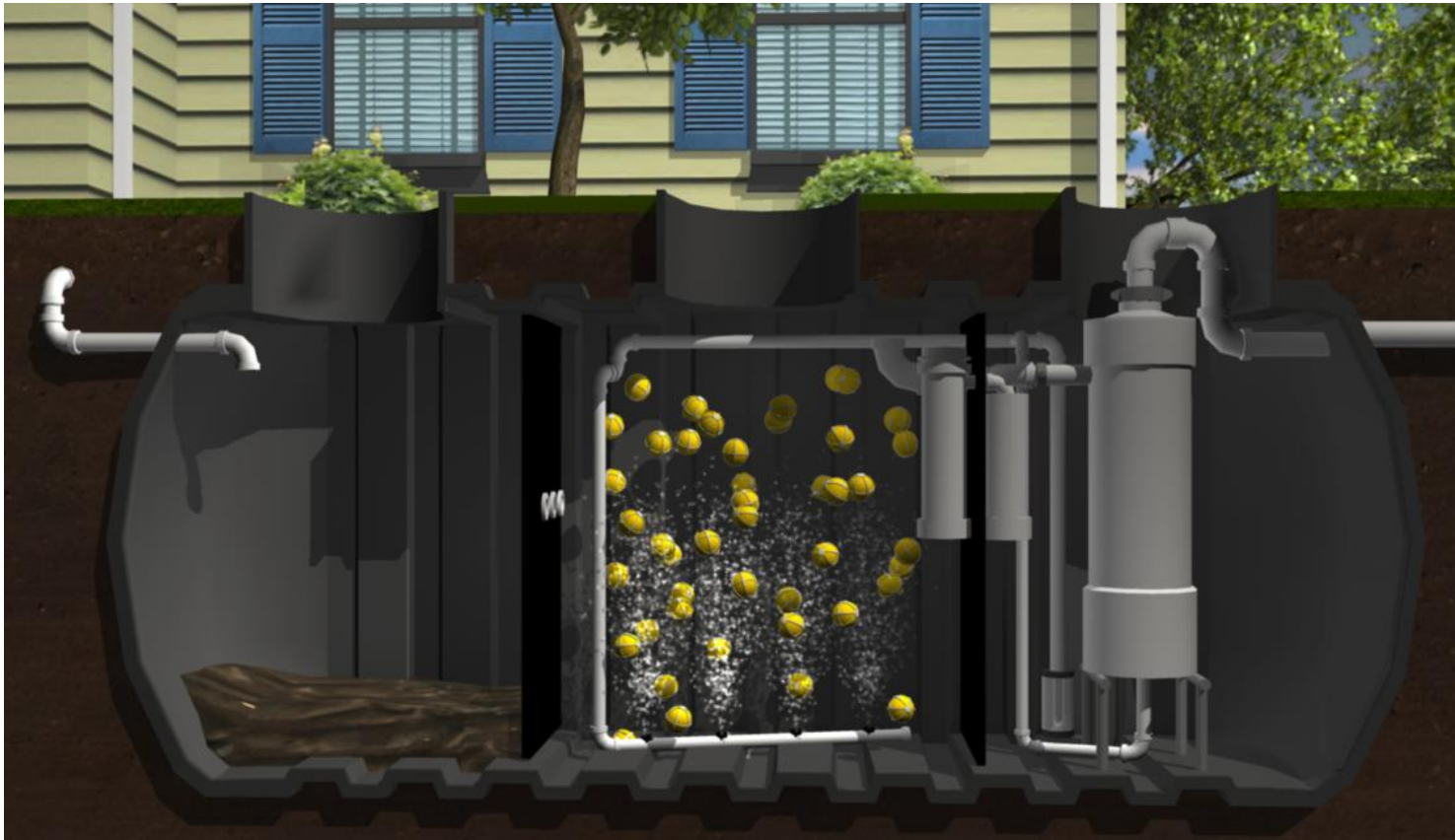
# TRADITIONAL SEPTIC SYSTEMS

- Concrete or plastic tanks feed large leach fields, and soil filters wastewater.
- 26 million septic tanks blanket the US (24% of homes), and the number is growing.
- The EPA says 10% to 20% malfunction each year, polluting groundwater, lakes and rivers.
